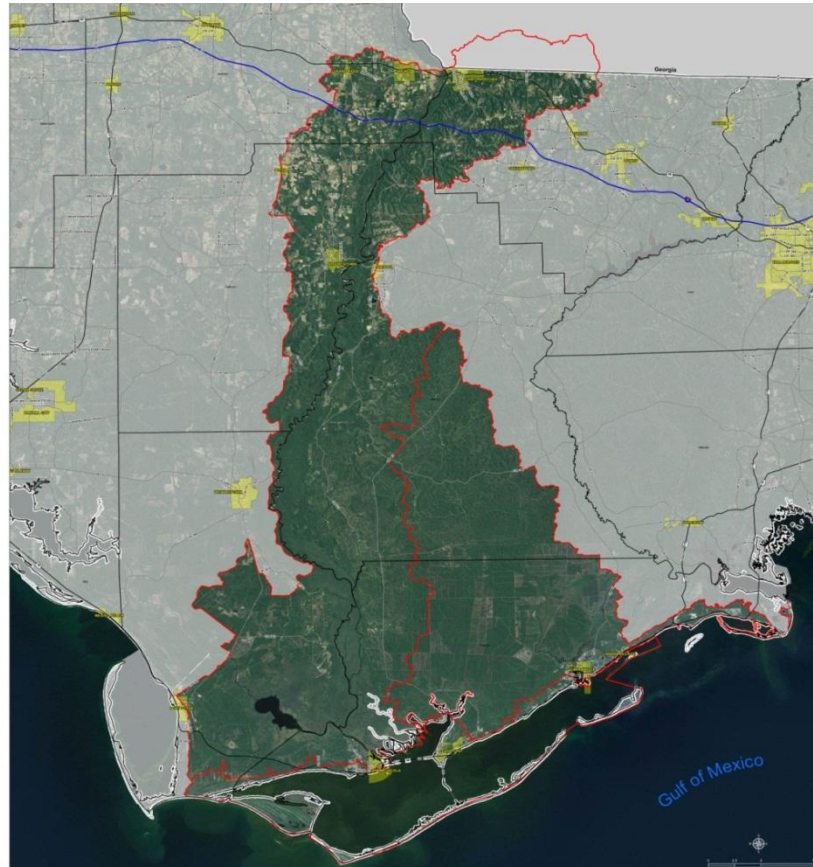

WATERSHED LOCATOR

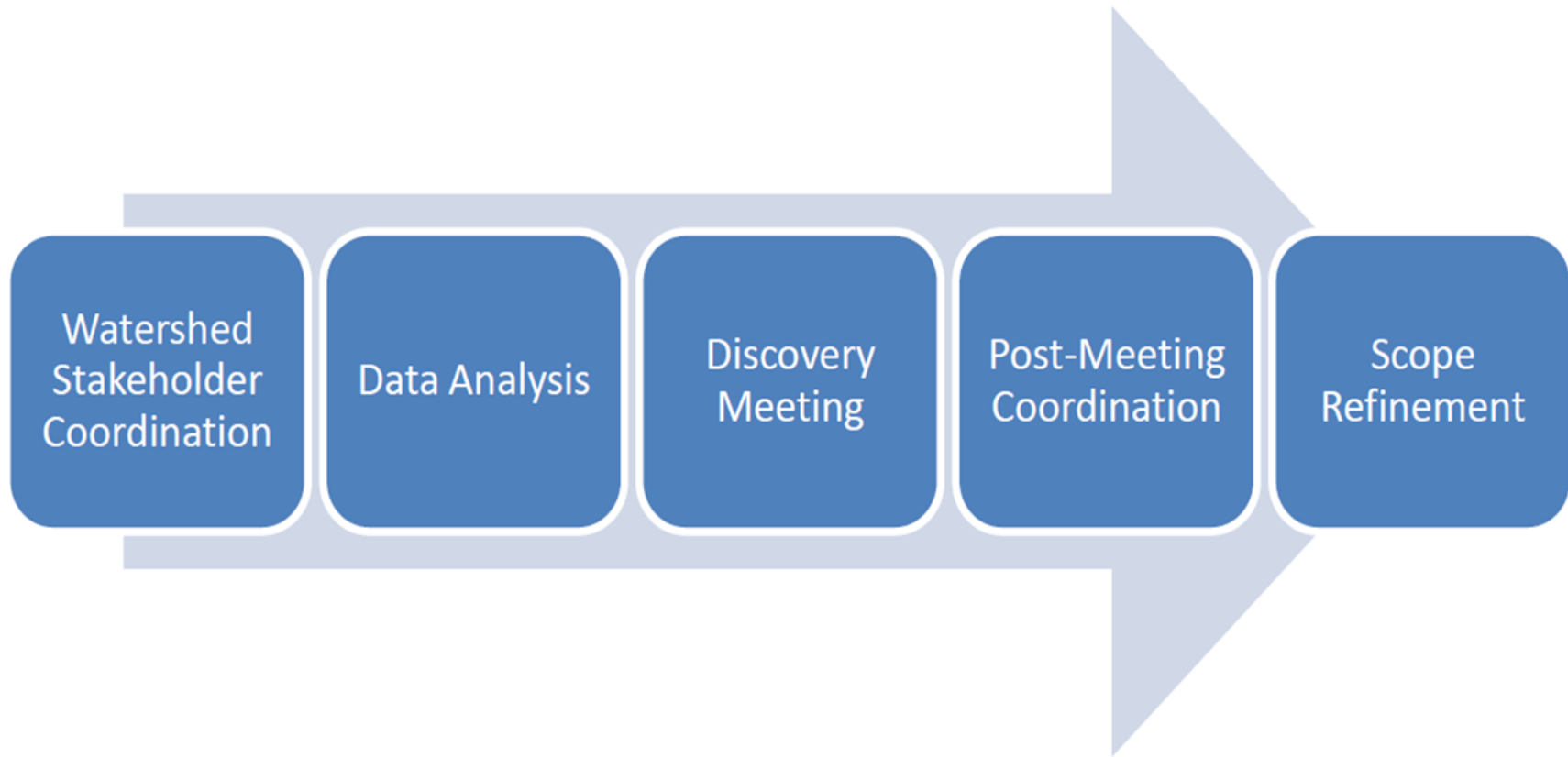
